## **Semester One, 2020 Student Reports**

Student's semester 1 reports will be available on Thursday 25th June via Xuno. Information on how to access these reports will be sent with the notification via Xuno when the reports are available.

The reports will include information on student achievement for each curriculum area taught, and will include:

- a description of the areas of the Victorian Curriculum F-10 taught
- graded on a 3 point scale for all areas of learning in Term 1 and on their engagement with remote learning for Term 2
- students will be given a brief comment on **ONE** area of learning that has been a particular strength during Semester One

## **Camps**

As of 21st June Camps are able to begin operating again. Unfortunately the 3/4 and 5/6 camp for 2020 have already been cancelled. The camp operators cancelled these before the restrictions were lifted. We are also aware that due to COVID-19 many families may not be able to afford this expense within the short timeframe.


Due to this we will look at some alternative ways to make sure that all students are able to experience the camp experience with their cohort. More details will follow later in the year and once we are aware of the restrictions lifted.

## **Camps Sports Excursion Fund (CSEF)**

## Road Safety

## Proposed parking change Lachlan St: Brimbank Council

### Parking on Lachlan St

Following a review by Brimbank Council regarding parking on Lachlan Street they have considered the following change to the 2 Minute parking restriction to significantly improve the operation needs of the parent drop-off and pick-up activities.

It is now proposed to replace the '2 Minute Parking 8-9am and 3-4pm School Days' with 'No Parking 8-9am and 3-4pm School Days'. This alternative parking restriction will operate better for its intended purpose. It will discourage parents from parking, leaving their cars and accompanying their children into the school grounds. This will also provide a better turn-over of drop-offs and pick-ups.

- To ensure the proposed No Parking restriction operates properly and avoids confusion by it users, the following information regarding the changes have been provided

## No parking signs

If there is a 'no parking' sign, you can stop for 2 minutes in that area:

- if you are picking up or dropping off passengers or goods
- you stay within 3 metres of your vehicle.

If you stop in, or partly in, an area showing a no parking sign and you are not picking up or dropping off passengers or goods, you are considered to be parked and can be fined. This is the case even if you stay with your vehicle.




*It is extremely important that if your child is unwell with any symptom related to corona-virus (cough, sneezing, sore throat, runny nose or a temperature) that they remain at home until no longer showing these symptoms.*
